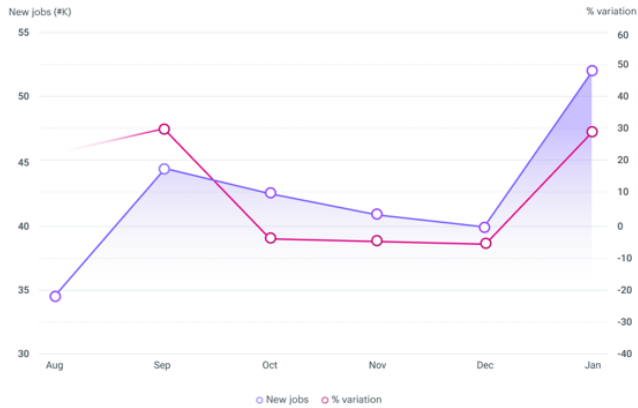

### Restaurant Job Market Sees Strong Rebound in January

January saw a sharp resurgence, with new job postings reaching their highest level in months, alongside a significant percentage variation.

This uptick suggests a mix of seasonal recovery and renewed hiring momentum, possibly driven by post-holiday consumer demand and operational recalibrations for the new year. The data, derived from publicly available self-reported sources, highlights the restaurant sector's ongoing workforce volatility and its sensitivity to economic and seasonal trends.

### Texas, California, and Florida Lead Restaurant Job Growth Nationwide

Restaurant job postings surged across the U.S. in January, with Texas, California, and Florida emerging as the top three states for hiring, according to Aura Intelligence's latest workforce insights. **Texas led the nation with 5,759 new job postings, reflecting a 26% month-over-month increase.** California followed closely with **4,220** postings, also up **26%**, while Florida saw a **23%** uptick with **3,929** new openings.

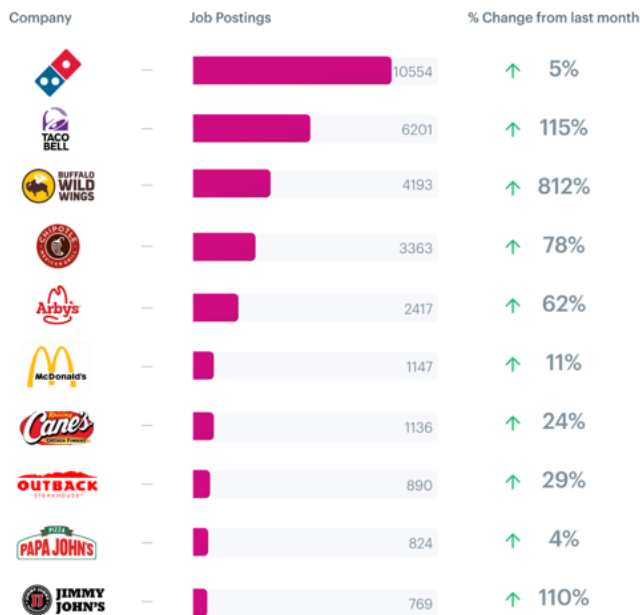
The most significant hiring momentum, however, came from **New York (57%), Michigan (59%), and Ohio (38%),** indicating growing labor demand in key metropolitan and suburban markets. Other states, including **Illinois (44%), Tennessee (41%), and Georgia (28%),** also experienced notable workforce expansion.

This data suggests a strong start to the year for restaurant hiring, likely driven by post-holiday consumer demand and staffing adjustments for Q1.

**Domino's** led the sector with **10,554** job postings, reflecting a steady **5%** increase from last month. However, the most striking growth came from **Buffalo Wild Wings**, which saw an explosive **812%** jump in job postings, signaling aggressive hiring—potentially in preparation for the Super Bowl rush.

**Taco Bell** and **Jimmy John's** also posted substantial increases at **115%** and **110%**, respectively, indicating a strong hiring push in the quick-service segment. **Chipotle**, **Arby's**, and **Outback Steakhouse** experienced notable gains as well, reflecting broader industry momentum. Even **McDonald's**, which typically maintains steady hiring cycles, saw an **11%** increase in new postings.

### Restaurant for Key Roles, Led by Team and Shift Managers

The restaurant industry witnessed a surge in job postings across various frontline and managerial roles in January, according to Aura Intelligence's latest workforce data. **Team Members** and **Crew Members** remained the most in-demand positions, with **2,253** and **2,157** new postings, growing by **99%** and **81%**, respectively. These roles reflect the ongoing need for entry-level staff to meet customer demand.

A standout trend was the **356%** spike in **Shift Manager** postings, signaling an urgent need for mid-level leadership to oversee daily operations. Similarly, **Cashier** postings saw an astonishing **203%** increase, likely tied to rising foot traffic and in-store service demand. **Bartender** roles also jumped by **139%**, indicating a strong recovery in full-service dining and bar establishments.

Managerial roles, including **General Managers** and **Assistant Managers**, saw more modest but steady increases, reinforcing the industry's push for stability in leadership amid fluctuating workforce dynamics.
